RE: NSW COVID-19 exposure locations and source investigation locations

Dear Club Presidents,

Given the latest cases of community transmission in NSW there is update health advice which applies to clubs, players, officials and spectators.

ACT Clubs and visiting teams to the ACT

Anyone in the ACT who has been in the Greater Sydney region of NSW on or after 26 April must check the COVID-19 Areas of Concern information on the ACT COVID-19 website to see if they have been in any current exposure locations or source investigation's locations.

Anyone who has attended an [exposure location](#) at the dates and times specified must immediately get tested for COVID-19, quarantine for 14 days from the time they were there, and call ACT Health on (02) 5124 6209.

Anyone who has attended a source [investigation location](#) at the dates and times specified must get tested for COVID-19 and self-isolate until a negative test result is received.

NSW Clubs and visiting teams to NSW

All club football activities that are ticketed in NSW now fall under one of the two categories below;

1. A non-controlled outdoor gathering (up to 200 people) (Clause 19)

These activities are restricted to 200 people (unless the gathering is a COVID-safe outdoor gathering with a COVID-19 Safety Plan)

2. A non-controlled outdoor gathering (up to 5,000 people) (Clause 19)

The organiser of a COVID-19 safe outdoor gathering is directed to ensure that the number of participants in the gathering is the lesser of;


- a) The number of persons equivalent to 1 person per 2 square metres of space of the premises in which the activity is conducted; or
- b) 5,000 persons.

All clubs are to update their plans accordingly.
